Adult Computer Classes at Temple Public Library



TEMPLE, TX (February 15, 2019) – Temple Public Library (TPL) will be hosting FREE adult computer classes. The classes cover basic computer skills, setting up email and an introduction to Microsoft Word.

On *February 23*, from 1-2 pm, TPL will offer a Basic Computer class. This class will help patrons explore the basic operations of a computer. If you aren't very

familiar with computers and their operations, this would be a perfect class for you.

Setting up Email class is scheduled for **March 9**, from 1-2:30 pm. Patrons will learn about the various email programs available on the internet. They will also have some time to set up an email account if they would like to do so.

Introduction to Microsoft Word class will be scheduled sometime in late March or early April. The class will focus on the basic operations of Microsoft Word. Attendees will learn how to create a New Document and shown some of the features to personalize the document. If you are interested in learning foundation skills of Microsoft Word, you should plan on attending this class.
