



Longmire House

Known to old time Temple residents as “Mrs. Longmire’s house,” this beautiful old home sits on the corner of North 9th and West Munroe. The Longmire home was built in 1932 for Dr. Arthur Carroll Scott, Jr. He was a prominent physician in Temple and was the son of Dr. A.C. Scott Sr., one of the founders of Scott and White Hospital. Dr. Scott, Jr. drew the final plans for the house himself and then personally supervised the construction of his new home. He designed the home in a very non-traditional way and made it truly unique in its time. Dr. Scott sold the home in 1936 when he bought the McCelvey mansion. Since that time, only four families have lived there.
